

Program Pre-Doctoral Awards: Master's Degree only

<i>Duration</i>	Max. of 2 years
<i>What does it cover?</i>	Fully funded: Visa, Airfare, registration and tuition fees, monthly stipend which covers accommodation, health insurance.
<i>Notes bout the program</i>	This program secures the university placement for successful candidates based on their fields of study, Test scores, diversity & other factors, at highly ranked US universities. All fields of study are accepted <i>except for</i> : Medicine, Veterinary Medicine & Dentistry
<i>Target Audience</i>	Senior students (Bachelor's degree) <u>with high GPA's</u> from all fields of study. Younger students, to inspire them and give them perspective on studying abroad in the US.
<i>Minimum Requirements</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ GPA = or > (3.5/4) Or being among the top 10% of the graduating class. (Ranking letter).▪ GRE Score of at least 308▪ TOEFL score of at least 90 on the iBT (90/120) Or IELTS score of at least 6.5▪ Interested candidates must already hold, or have been awarded their Bachelor's degrees, by the time of application.▪ The GRE and (TOEFL or IELTS) Score reports should be ready before April 30th 2017.▪ Important and detailed info will be explained during the presentation.
<i>When to apply?</i>	The competition window opens from January 2017 until the end of April 2017 Please note that: This competition is for academic year 2018/19, i.e. successful candidates will travel to the US on their Fulbright grants between (July – September) 2018.

Jordanians holding a U.S. passport or a Green Card are not eligible to apply.

**Program Foreign Language Teaching Assistantships (FLTA) Fellowship
(Teaching Arabic for non-native speakers in the US)**

Duration 9 months

What does it cover? Fully funded: Visa, Airfare, registration and tuition fees, monthly stipend which covers accommodation, health insurance.

Notes about the program The grantees will be teaching Arabic to American students in the US for 9 months, and they will also:

- Enhance their English language skills during the grant period.
- Enhance their teaching techniques and knowledge (By studying 4 subjects at the host institute)
- Interact with the American society and learn more about the American culture.
- Get the chance to introduce the Jordanian culture to their peers in the US.

Target Audience

- English Department senior students for both bachelor's and master's degrees.
- Students from other Humanities departments are welcome if they have good English skills and are interested in teaching Arabic for non-native speakers.
- Young English teachers, and English teachers-to-be.
- Interested young Faculty members from Humanities dept.'s
- Preferable age of candidates is below 35.

Minimum Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree (No conditions on the GPA)
- English proficiency:

- ITP (Institutional TOEFL Program) (Local TOEFL test) a score of at least 550 Or TOEFL iBT score of 80 Or IELTS score of 6
- Prior teaching experience
- Interested candidates must already hold, or have been awarded their Bachelor's degrees, by the time of application.
- Important and detailed info will be explained during the presentation.

When to apply?

The competition window opens from January 2017 until the end of April 2017.

This competition is for academic year 2018/19, i.e. successful candidates will travel to the US on their Fulbright grants between (July – September) 2018.

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Program Post-Doctoral Awards (Research)

<i>Duration</i>	Min. of 4 month Max. of 9 months
<i>What does it cover?</i>	Monthly stipend for the grant period and health insurance. <u>This grant doesn't cover airfare.</u>
<i>Notes about the program</i>	Candidates should secure the following: A release letter from their home university. An invitation letter from the US host institute. And they should submit a research proposal.
<i>Target Audience</i>	Faculty Members from all fields of study.
<i>Minimum Requirements</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Doctoral degree or equivalent• 5 Publications (other than the PhD dissertation)• 5 years of experience• English Language proficiency <p>Important and detailed info will be explained during the presentation.</p>
<i>When to apply?</i>	The competition window opens from January 2017 until the end of April 2017.
