

H2020 Framework Programme has allocated EUR 215 million from the 2015 budget for the Individual Fellowship (**IF**) action of the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions. **Individual Fellowships** provide opportunities to acquire and transfer new knowledge and to work on research in a European context (EU Member States and Associated Countries) or outside Europe.

**Pay attention:** Individual Fellowship action has two types: European Fellowships, Global Fellowships. Third countries are eligible to participate in European Fellowships;

*ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS for the standard European fellowships:*

1. YOU must be an Experienced Researcher: s/he must, at the deadline for the submission of proposals, be in possession of a doctoral degree or have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience.
2. The researcher may be of any nationality.
3. The researcher must move or have moved (transnational mobility) from any country to the MS or AC where the beneficiary is located.

**DEADLINE for 2015 calls is 10<sup>th</sup> September 2015**
