 - Course descriptions for all courses offered by each Department or academic unit.

In the course description, the following information about each course is presented:

- Course Number.
- Course Title.
- Course Prerequisite(s).
- Course Description.
- Course Credit Hours depicted in three numbers between two parenthesis, having the following interpretations :

Numbers between Parenthesis Following Course Title (From Left to Right) e.g. (3:3-0):

- **The first number indicates the number of the course credit hours applied toward graduation.**
- **The second number indicates the number of 50-minute lectures (or equivalent) given each week during a regular semester.**
- **The third number indicates the portion of the course credit hours designated for laboratory activities.**
