Chapter Three: Data Analysis and Results

Pharmacokinetic Parameters' Analysis

The primary endpoint targeted parameters; area under the plasma concentration time

curve from time zero to the last sampling time and to infinity (AUC0-t, AUC0-∞

respectively), were calculated using a computer software program specially designed for

such purposes, Kinetica 2000 version 4.2, Innaphase Corporation, France.

The primary parameter; the maximum concentration of the drug in the plasma samples

(Cmax), was determined from the plasma profile of each subject.

The secondary endpoint targeted parameters; half-life of drug $(T_{1/2})$ and elimination

constant (K_{el}) were calculated as well using Kinetica 2000 version 4.2. The secondary

parameter; time required to reach maximum concentration of the drug (Tmax) was

determined from the plasma profile of each subject.

Statistical Analysis

All data were statistically analyzed with SPSS version 17. Results were compared

using one-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) and paired student T-test.

Values of p<0.05 were considered to be significant.

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
