3.5 Stability of Analytical Solution

The stability of solution should be evaluated by storing the solution under known concentration at room temperature and fridge for 24 and 48 hours compared to fresh standard solution. 100% concentration level is analyzed against standard solution, for each sample the concentration is 120 μ g/mL of esomeprazole, and 80 μ g/mL of tadalafil.

The stability results within stated limit of range 98%-102% in 24 hrs are listed in tables (14,15) and figures (19,20).
