He has given me the Book and made me a Prophet. He has made me blessed wherever I am, placing upon me the obligations of Salah [prayers] and to pay the Zakah [charity] as long as I live.

And He has obligated me to be kind to my mother and not to become arrogant or rebellious.

Peace be upon me the day I was born, the day I die, and the day when I shall be raised up again alive.' So said Jesus, the son of Mary.

He made a statement of truth which people continue to dispute, for it is not fitting for God to have a son, glory be to Him.
